“Strong, Secure, Engaged (SSE) is an ambitious defence policy predicated on a significant increase in defence spending and an especially ambitious planned increase in spending on capital procurement (equipment and infrastructure purchases – Overall, the new funding framework outlined in the policy would see spending increase by 70 per cent from 2016/2017 to 2026/2027.”
(from \$18.9 billion to \$32.7 billion)

- “If Strong, Secure, Engaged is implemented as outlined, it will see a complete paradigm shift in the amount of annual spending on capital. In inflation-adjusted dollars, the policy would see annual spending on capital (both infrastructure and equipment) quadruple over the next seven years on a cash basis.”
